We set out the principles below, all of which are in line with our sustainability policy and framework. This policy covers Severfield plc and its respective business divisions.

Our Commitment

As part of our policy and in line with our ISO 14001 certification, we will:

- Gather data and complete a baseline assessment to estimate our impact and the influence of our wider value chain on nature and biodiversity.
- Carry out value chain scoping to understand nature-related risks better. In line with those findings, we will also set appropriate targets.
- Engage with nature conservation organisations to help us improve our impact on biodiversity and nature.

We will review this policy annually or if anything significant changes.
